**Minutes:** Minutes of the Parish Council meeting of 12 January 2016 approved (proposed BL, seconded BG)

- **1 Finance:** BG reported a balance of £11,225. BG reported the precept of £6,300 had been received in one tranche. BG raised concern over the cost of grass cutting and maintenance which was rising year on year. BG to circulate a list of what is being carried out by D.S. Stevens.

## 5 Highways:

- RN & DP attending a meeting with Pewsey and Wilcott PCs to discuss C52 report recommendations. Concern was raised about the traffic flow to local businesses i.e. Woodborough garden centre if C52 was blocked. Highways are working on traffic flow options.
- RN reported that the setting up and operational costs of SID shared between 6-7 PCs would be £250 p.a. per parish and thereafter £70 p.a. Each parish would have the device in 2 week tranches, 4 times a year. It was agreed unanimously to proceed.
- 6 Footpaths: No report
- 7 Localism, environment and flooding:
  - BL and PH noted sporadic, but short lived flooding and RN reminded councillors to submit any serious issues on the Priority spreadsheet.
  - BL reported that following the Discussion Forum on superfast broadband issues hosted by Claire Perry, 90% of the region would be receiving high speed broadband by 2017.
- 8 Police Matters: PH to look at providing a link to the Neighbourhood Watch on website.
- **9 Village Hall:** The VH received a cheque for £3.5k from the estate of Pete Lewis to be used on projects to benefit villagers and ideas are being canvassed. A lunch celebration on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> June to commemorate the Queen's 90<sup>th</sup> birthday. Pub night 18 January and another scheduled for May. Police Commissioner Election day on 5<sup>th</sup> May.
